

CHANGES AND REVISIONS: HOW, WHAT, WHEN

Programmatic Changes: Any revision to the scope or approved program objectives, regardless of budgetary implications, shall be approved by the U.S. Department of Education, prior to implementation.

Budget Revisions: Transfer of funds between line items shall not exceed 20% of the agency-approved budget for both line items. However, federal regulations state that budget transfers among direct cost categories cannot exceed 10% of the total budget without approval of the program officer. Additionally, appropriate justification for the revision is required.

Termination and suspension: Assistance under any federal program to which this paragraph is applicable may be terminated in whole or in part if the Secretary determines, after giving the recipient reasonable notice and opportunity to be heard, that the recipient has failed to carryout its approved project proposal accordance with the applicable law and the terms of such assistance or has otherwise to failed to comply with the law, regulation, assurance, terms, or conditions applicable to the grant or contract.

Unexpended Funds: In the event that the amounts previously awarded have not been obligated pursuant to the approved projects, and, in the judgement of the Secretary, will not be obligated for such purposes, the Secretary may, upon notice to the recipient, reduce the amount of the grantor contract to an amount consistent with the recipient's needs pursuant to regulations regarding termination and suspension for causes.
